

## Literacy

**Texts:** Mrs Noah's pockets, Aesop's Fables, Klasson's Hat trilogy

### Narrative:

- Retelling the story of 'The Musicians of Bremen'
- Innovate by using different animals and changing the ending.

### Poetry:

- Write and perform poems based on animal sounds.

### Instructional Writing:

- Following talk from the visitor, children write instructions for looking after the pet.

## Computing

- Using a camera and transferring images to the computer.
- Using them to create local area information poster/leaflet.
- Links to geography

## Visitors

- Visit from pet owner to ask questions about their pet (snake, lizard etc.)
- Possible visit from Tiggywinkle's or Wheatley Birds of Prey
