Problem solving

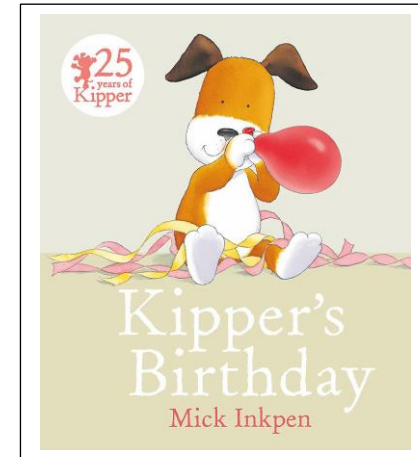


Personal, Social and Emotional Development
